

DIRECT DEBIT PROGRAM

What is Direct Debit?

Direct Debit is a free, electronic debit system that makes paying your water and sewer bill easier. Direct Debit automatically deducts the exact amount of your water and sewer bill from your bank account.

How does Direct Debit work?

Each quarter, you will receive your water and sewer bill in the normal manner. There will be ample time to allow any concerns that you may have about your bill to be discussed with the Authority. The payment will be withdrawn up to three businesses days before the due date that is noted on your quarterly bill.

Direct Debit is not available for partial payments.

How do I sign up for Direct Debit?

Just complete the authorization form and return it along with a cancelled check to the Authority. The form can be returned to our Administration Office located at 7811 New Falls Road, Levittown, PA. Forms can be returned by mail to:
