Direct Debit Program

What is Direct Debit?

Direct debit is a free, electronic debit system that makes paying your water and sewer bill easier. Direct Debit automatically deducts the exact amount of your water and sewer bill directly from your bank account.

How does Direct Debit work?

Each quarter you will receive your water/sewer bill in the usual manner. Your bill will state the date in which the amount of the bill will be deducted from your bank account. There will be ample time to allow any concerns that you may have about your bill to be discussed with the Authority. During the week of your due date, the exact amount of the bill is withdrawn from your account. Direct Debit is not available for partial payments.
