#### MANAGING DIRECTOR'S REPORT

## PROJECT # WWTP-213: REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING FOUR SCUM SKIMMERS FOR FOUR (4) SECONDARY SEDIMENTATION TANKS AT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UNDER COSTARS CONTRACT # 388549

Dr. Rajput explained that the existing metal troughs in secondary tanks #1-4 are original and in need of replacement. These troughs allow the removal of oil, grease, scum, and other floatable material from the surface of the secondary sedimentation tanks. Each tank has an existing 12" diameter 25' long trough which is manually operated. The troughs are metal and have deteriorated over the past 70 years. The existing wall bearings and associated hardware also need to be replaced.

A proposal was obtained from Sherwood Logan & Associates, Inc., the authorized sales representative of Fiber Glass Systems, L.P., Manufacturer of fiberglass reinforced plastic (FRP) Scum Skimmers to supply and deliver four (4) complete FRP Scum Skimmers to replace the four 12" diameter 25' long scum trough skimmers with wall bearings and hardware. The replacement trough material will consist of FRP with 316 stainless steel end collars with UHMW glides and EPDM seals FRP slotted collection pipe. The quoted price for each skimmer is \$18,050.00. Therefore, the total quote-for four (4) skimmers is \$72,200.00; with an estimated freight cost of \$7,188.00. This price is under COSTARS Contract #388549 and has an approximate lead time of 20 weeks. Dr. Rajput recommend to the Board for its consideration to purchase four (4) complete FRP Scum Skimmers from Sherwood-Logan & Associates, Inc., located at 2140 Renard Court, Annapolis, MD 21401, under COSTARS Contract #388549 for a total amount of \$79,388.00 with freight cost.

# PROJECT #WWTP 214: REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING GEAR DRIVE IN SECONDARY SEDIMENTATION TANKS 1 AND 2 AT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

Dr. Rajput gave an overview of the condition of the gear drives for secondary tanks #1 and #2. These are original and reaching the end of their life. Both gear drives and gear boxes are obsolete. The existing gear drives are Foote Jones with Hub City Gear Boxes.

A proposal was obtained from Sherwood Logan & Associates, Inc., the authorized sales representative of Connexus Industries Inc., manufacturer of Koellmann S1-SCD8.2 triple output shaft drive units. The Koellmann units are nearly direct replacement units and should integrate into the existing units with small modifications.

The total quote for each complete gear drive unit is \$82,499.00; and under COSTARS Contract #388549. The approximate lead time for the two (2) gear drives is 26 weeks. Dr. Rajput recommended to the Board for its consideration for purchasing two (20 complete Koellmann S1-SCD8.2 triple output shaft drive units for secondary tanks 1 & 2 from Sherwood-Logan & Associates, Inc., located at 2140 Renard Court, Annapolis, MD 21401, under COSTARS Contract #388549 for a total contract amount of \$166,498.00 with estimated freight cost of approximately \$1,500.00.

# PROJECT #WWTP-215: FURNISH AND DELIVER ONE COMPLETE GRINDER FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE EXISTING GRINDER AT BIRCH VALLEY WASTEWATER PUMP STATION (UNDER COSTARS CONTRACT # 391243)

Dr. Rajput explained that as a result of the failed grinder at Birch Valley Pump Station, quotations were obtained for a replacement. JWC Environmental, Inc., under COSTARS Contract #391243, submitted a proposal with the lowest price, totaling \$29,722.30 for a complete Muffin Monster unit including the controller to replace the failed Franklin-Miller grinder. The above stated price from JWC Environmental represents a 25% discount which is substantially less than the Franklin-Miller quoted price of \$74,170.00 to replace their failed grinder. We plan to use the existing grinder's stainless guide rails and

mounting bracket(s). The existing controller will be used as a backup for other pump stations with Franklin Miller grinders in place. The quoted price does not include the cost of installation. Based on review of the quotation and grinder's specifications, Dr. Rajput recommended to the Board for its consideration purchasing a complete Muffin Monster (CMD2410-XD2.0) with Controller (PC2200) for a total amount not to exceed \$30,000.00 from JWC Environmental Inc. under COSTARS Contract # 391243.

Dr. Rajput informed the Board that one filter is completed and J.P. Smith Contractors, Inc. is currently working on Filter No. 2. The contractor has removed the existing filter media and are currently painting and coating the filter.

CONTRACT #WWTP-401A: FURNISH AND DELIVER COMPLETE ULTRAVIOLET DISINFECTION SYSTEM TO REPLACE EXISTING CHLORINE DISINFECTION SYSTEM UNDER COSTARS CONTRACT #016-123 AT THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

The contractor has delivered three units of Ultraviolet system to the plant and the remaining three units are scheduled for delivery in approximately three weeks.

## CONTRACT #WWTP-401B: INSTALLATION OF ULTRAVIOLET DISINFECTION SYSTEM IN THE EXISTING CHLORINE CONTACT BASINS AT THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT UNDER COSTARS CONTRACT #016-187

The contractor received a shipment of three UV units delivered to the plant. A project progress meeting is scheduled for the second week of February.

## PROJECT #WWTP-440: TURNKEY ENGINEERING DESIGN BUILD COMPLETE SOLAR PV CANOPY SYSTEM OVER UV/CHLORINE DISINFECTION BASINS AT THE WASTEWATER TREAMENT PLANT

Dr. Rajput reported that the UV system will be moving forward now that Ingram Engineering Services has completed the utility location and conducted several test borings for soil investigation around the perimeter of the chlorine contact tanks pertaining to foundation design for the solar canopy over the UV system.

## WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM MAINTENANCE PROGRAM: REHABILITATION / REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING WATER MAINS – PHASE 7

Dr. Rajput reported the water main replacement on Bittersweet Road has been completed. This project involved replacement of approximately 1800 linear feet of 6-inch Cast Iron Pipe (CIP) with 6-inch Ductile Iron Pipe (DIP). The contractor has completed restoration of the site including replacement of sidewalk, curb, apron and driveways affected by the project.

#### WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT NPDES PERMIT

Dr. Rajput have received draft NPDES permit from PADEP which we are currently reviewing.

#### WATER TREATMENT PLANT DRBC ANNUAL EFFLUENT MONITORING REPORT
